LEARN

■ A linking verb links the subject of a sentence with other words that tell about the subject.

A linking verb does not show action.

A shark **is** a meat-eating fish. Whale sharks **are** the largest of all sharks.

■ Different forms of the verb be are often used as linking verbs. Use the form of be that agrees with the subject of the sentence.
